The third Diocesan Faith and Life Convention will be held on **Saturday, 24<sup>th</sup> September** in Our Lady and St Patrick's College, Knock. Details of speakers, workshops and early-bird deals can be found on the website: [faithandlifeconvention.org](http://faithandlifeconvention.org) The Faith and Life Convention is a forum for people from across the diocese, and beyond, to gather together and take part in a range of conversations about the meaning of faith and its relevance to every area of our lives. Sarah Teather, of the Jesuit Refugee Service, will be the keynote speaker and will invite us to reflect on the current refugee crisis while sharing her own journey of discernment which led her away from the benches in parliament to her current role. Our discussion will focus on how the Church, and we as people of faith, position ourselves in current debates and engage more readily in the public square. An essential element of the day will be the afternoon workshops which will explore the place of faith in many different areas of our lives. Each participant can attend two workshops which will be booked on a first come, first served basis. Early booking is essential.
